### PUTRAJAYA & AGRICULTURAL HERITAGE PARK 'Most intelligent city in Malaysia'



The journey from Kuala Lumpur to Putrajaya will takes approximately 50 minutes via the highway. Our first stop will be at Taman Warisan or Agricultural Heritage Park – a 'living' museum for mango, rubber, cocoa, palm oil, durian, jackfruit, herbs and etc. A demonstration on the entire rubber manufacturing process from the time it is tapped and churned out as fully smoked sheets will be shown during tour.

Next proceed to Putrajaya Government Centre where numerous new government complexes located in this new township. The most imposing structure in Putrajaya is the thin pinkish Putra Mosque. Standing beside Dataran Putra and facing the Putrajaya Lake, it incorporates architectural elements from Turkmenistan, Kazakhstan and Morocco. Another eye-catching building is the Prime Minister's office – Putra Perdana. Other interesting places are Putra Bridge and Prime Minister's residence Seri Perdana.

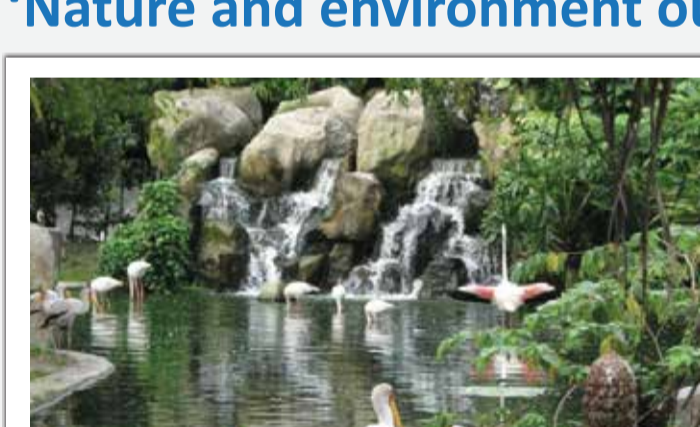

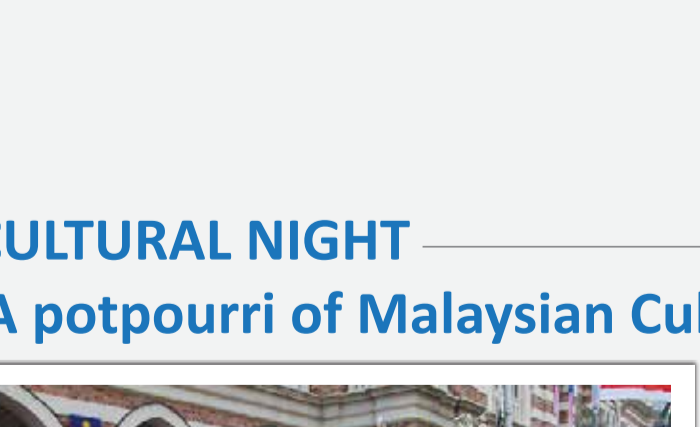

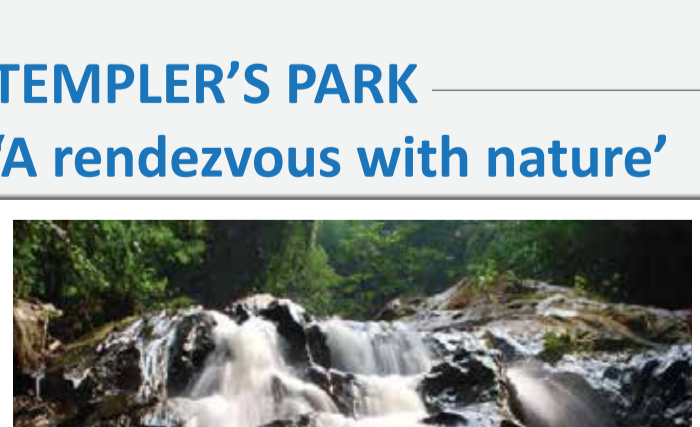
